



COUNTRY PROFILE


Wildlife-lover? Our trip to Rwanda will delight you. The Virunga Mountains, spread across five volcanoes, offer a rich ecosystem utterly unique to East Africa. Crossing the border into the Democratic Republic of Congo and Uganda, this is the only place in the world where you'll encounter the endangered mountain gorilla. Majestic, gentle and surprisingly human-like, observing these creatures in their natural habitat is a special experience.

Head to Nyungwe National Park, and you'll encounter chimpanzees swinging through the canopy; in Akagera, you'll find lions, elephants, zebras and giraffes roaming the savannah, many of which have been recently re-introduced to Rwanda.

WHEN TO GO?

Rwanda has a highland tropical climate. Dry season runs from June to September and December to February, making this the ideal time to visit. Wet season occurs from March to May, and October to November.

Think red rolling dunes and saltrich seas, Biblical mountains

Jordan's top sight is undoubtedly Petra, an ancient Nabatean city carved into the pink sandstone cliffs. One of the most magical travel moments out there, in our opinion, is uncovering the ancient city by candlelight, with the atmospheric strings of live Bedouin music providing the perfect soundtrack. Floating in the Dead Sea is also a must, as is canyoning through the ravines of Wadi Mujib.




